# **Retreat Schedule**

- Sewing Room opens Thursday, at 9:00 am.
   Please do not arrive extra early. Retreat committee needs a little time to set up, and seating is assigned.
- Guest Room Keys distributed for cabin check in at 3:00 pm.
- All Meals are in the Center Dining Room [Meals are included, and scheduled starting with Lunch on Thursday.]
- Day Stitchers are entitled daily lunches.
- Meals times will be posted daily.
- Cabin Checkout time is 10:00 am, on Sunday.
   Don't forget to turn in your room key.
- Retreat closes promptly at 3:00 pm on Sunday.
- Don't forget your retreat nametag.

## **Directions to Retreat Center**

I-75 to Exit 224, State Road 301. Go North on 301. Turn Right onto 80<sup>th</sup> Ave. East. Marathon Gas Station on the corner and Eye Clinic on the other corner. Turn Left on 25<sup>th</sup> St. E. Turn slight right into Retreat Center Grounds.

The Multi-Purpose Room (MPR) will be on your right. Parking is available at the MPR.

FYI--Center is conveniently located near Walgreens, Publix, Walmart, the Outlet Mall and restaurants.

Golf Carts rentals are no longer available thru Day Spring. You can drive between the Multi-Purpose Room, dining hall and the cabins, if necessary.

**Center Policies**: The Retreat Center is a tobacco/smoking free environment. Adult beverages may be brought into the Multipurpose room or in your cabin. Open containers are not permitted outside of these spaces.

**Swimming,** heated pool available, requires a signed waiver, which will be available. **Bring a swim suit and your own towel**.

Linens, Pillow and Towels are provided. Bring your own fav pillow if you wish.

Ice and large refrigerator provided in the kitchenette of the sewing room. Cabins have small refrigerators and a coffee pot, coffee and creamer pods.

## **SEWING, IRONING, CUTTING**

- Every participant will have one 6 ft. long table as their workspace.
- Personal sewing tables will be allowed.
- There will be several shared ironing stations with irons.

### We provide irons for our ironing stations, bring one to share if you can, labeled.

- There will be several large, raised and not raised, cutting mat areas to share.
- You will have electricity near your table, bring a surge protector power strip (not a household cord!).
   Please put your name on it.
- You can bring your own **CHAIR** if that helps you be more comfortable, or a pillow to put in the provided chair.
- Personal non-cycling irons are allowed, to minimize contact. They MUST be non-cycling. If they turn
  off automatically, they are cycling and may blow the fuses.
- Your sewing machine and all machine supplies including tools such as lint brush, mini screwdriver and oil. Don't forget the power cord and foot pedal.
- Rotary cutter and new blades, small cutting mat to use at your space if you wish.
- Scissors, rulers, full bobbins, pins, thread and of course fabric and patterns.
- Room lighting is bright but you may bring a personal lamp.
- Your personal projects. We have four days, you will get a lot of sewing done!!
- Extra fabrics for demos and retreat exchange block.
- Ring the Bell for Show and Tell: When a project if finished, you can Ring the Bell for Show and Tell. You can show off your projects anytime during the retreat.
- A portable design wall, or flannel to lay on the floor. You may pin to the fabric room dividers but NOTHING CAN BE ATTACHED, PINNED OR TAPED TO ANY WALLS.
