

S2MQG Go Baby!! Baby Quilt Pattern

Modified to include additional instructions.

Finished Size: Crib - 40" x 40"

Materials:

Aqua Solid 3/8 yard (10" x WOF needed)
White Print 3/4 yard
Red Tone-on-Tone 7/8 yard
Multicolor Stripe 5/8 yard (includes binding)
Backing 2 3/4 yards (1 1/4 - 1 1/2 yard works)
Batting 44" x 44"

Cutting:

Aqua Solid

(4) squares (A) 9" x 9"

White Print

(3) Strips 4 1/2" x WOF for band A and B

(4) squares (A) 9" x 9"

Red Tone-on-Tone

(2) Strips 4 1/2" x WOF for band A

(5) squares (B) 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"

Multicolor Stripe

(5) Strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding

(1) Strips 4 1/2" x WOF for band B

Making the Block Units

Unit 1 – Half Square Triangles (HSTs)

Pair one 9" aqua A square with one 9" white A square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square.

Sew a scant 1/4" on each side of the marked line, then cut along the line.

Press the units open toward the darker fabric and trim to 8 1/2". Repeat to make 8 units total.

Each pair of squares yields 2 HSTs, for a total of 8 HSTs.

Unit 1
Make 8

Unit 2 – Band A

Sew one red strip to one white strip to create a Band A strip set. Repeat to make a second strip set. Cut each strip set into 4½" segments to yield 16 Unit 2 pieces. Join the Unit 2 pieces in pairs, as shown, to make 8 Four Patch units.



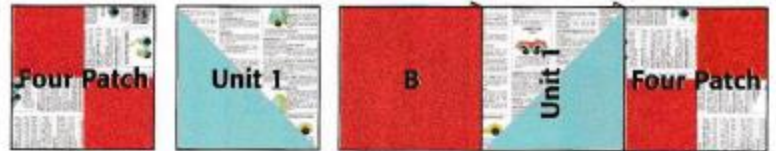
Unit 3 – Band B

Sew the multicolor strip to the white strip to create a Band B strip set. Cut the strip set into 8½" segments to make 4 Unit 3 pieces.



Assembly

Arrange all units according to the diagram. Sew together in rows, then join the rows to complete the block.

Quilting and Finishing

Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired, then finish the edges with your preferred binding.
