
Harper's Garden

Fabric Requirements

F1 background - FQ

F2 Red - F8

F3 Green- 6" x 12"

F4 Pink – F8

F5 Taupe - 6" x 6"

Cutting

F1- Cut $4 - 9\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" and $4 - 5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " for flying geese & HSTs

F2- Cut 4 - 5" x 5" and $1 - 5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " for flying geese & HSTs

F3- Cut $2 - 5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " for HSTs


F4- Cut 4 - 5" x 5" for flying geese

F5 - Cut 1 - 51/2" x 51/2" for HSTs

Assemble Half Square Triangles - HSTs



Using a mechanical pencil draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the F1 squares.
Align 1 dark and 1 light square right sides together.



Stitch a scant 1/4" on opposite sides of marked line. Cut on marked line. Trim unit to measure **5" with seams**. Press seams open. Yields 2 HSTs.



Make 8 assorted HSTs. Press seams open.

Assemble Flying Geese Units



Using a mechancial pencil draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of assorted F2 or F4 squares.



Stitch on marked line.




Trim top layer leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Do not trim away background fabric.




Press toward corner.

Repeat steps with a second square charm.



Make a total of4 flying geese units.

Assemble Block



Block should measure 18½" x 18½" with seams.
